Straight line winds caused extensive damage just north of Paris. The path covered nearly 9 miles but was not continuous and was 300 yards at its greatest width. Three mobile homes, two businesses and a residential home were completely destroyed. One other residence along with the New Bethel Baptist Church received substantial damage. Several other buildings experienced minor damage. Numerous large trees were snapped and uprooted.
